


Museo Novecento



Welcome. The Museo Novecento in Florence, opened in 2014, houses a rich permanent collection of 20th century works, and is the venue for temporary exhibitions of internationally important modern and contemporary art.





WHERE

The museum is located in a historical building a few steps from the Santa Maria Novella railway station, making it easily accessible by public transport (tramway, train, bus) but also with your own means of transport, which you can leave in the nearby station car park.



TIMETABLES

The museum is open daily from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m., except on Thursdays, when it is closed.



TICKETS

Tickets can be purchased online or at the ticket office on the day of the visit.
